Standard for permits for the grant of permission for disposal of mineral extracted incidental to developmental activities

Whereas Sh./ Messer M/s DLF Ltd. Through Sh. Deepak Bhandari R/o 9th Floor, DLF Centre Sansad Marg, New Delhi has applied for the grant of a short term permit under rule 27 to 35 of the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking & Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of illegal Mining Rules 2012, for disposal of 8681 M.T. of Ordinary Clay excavated / removed from The Skycourt Village Nawada Fathepur, Sector 86, Gurgaon digging of foundation/basement The applicant has paid royalty in advance and application fees Rs. 38023/- vide D.D.No. 825812 dated 31.01.14 and Security amount is already deposited and adjusted vide permit No. 1325 dt. 23.07.13 & permit No. 1357 dt. 17.10.13 (50% of the amount of royalty).

2. The permission is hereby granted for disposal of 8681 MT mineral Ordinary Clay excavated /removed from the aforesaid area subject to the conditions that the permit holder will abide by the safety guards for such excavation or removal.
3. The permit holder shall transport/disposal off the ordinary clay/ earth from the site of the excavation , only by issuing a Mineral Transit Pass.
4. The amount of security deposit shall entail no interest. The security amount shall be refunded within a period of three months in case the same is not forfeited or required to be detained for any other purpose under this permit.
5. Any sum due from the permit holder shall be recovered from him as an arrear of land Revenue.

The permission shall be valid up to 07.03.2014.
